Autobiography

Moreover, I am open to getting new knowledge and I am good at languages as I speak good English, French, Arabic, and Farsi. However, my science mindedness and inclination for self-development were at stake in Iran as there were hardly any opportunities to improvement.

I was looking for the opportunities to use in order to change my life completely. I had my brother as an example to follow. He is considered to be one of the most successful doctors in Germany, whose services are always in demand among the patients (Hannover Medical School /



Medizinische Hochschule Hannover, Hannover, DEU, 07/2008, 01/2014). Nevertheless, I am an independent woman who does not get any support from the members of the family. On the contrary, I always try my best to take care of my parents who have lived all their lives in Iran. My father is a PhD holder but he is in his advanced years and cannot provide for the family.

I never neglect my commitments to the family in Iran. Therefore, need for money made me look for a job and I tried myself as a teacher for adults interested in getting to know the basics of computer use and learning the fundamental principles of software engineering. That work experience was beneficial for me, since I had the possibility not only to share my skills and expertise with other people, but also to improve my own knowledge. Working with people, I got to know much about communication, interpersonal relations, motivation, tolerance, respect and other things which make life meaningful.

Financial problems are even the reasons for my inability to afford proper treatment when I am suffering from such illnesses as hyperthyroidism and migraine with painful severe headache. I came through a serious disease with numerous complications last year and I found it extremely complicated to get the medicine to soothe the suffering; I consider that period to be a severe test of my character and readiness to cope with any hardships to gain success and prove to myself that I can work tirelessly and endure everything to utilize all my potentials and give back to the



community. Even being unable to afford the services of a doctor, I was struggling not to fall behind with my studies, however challenging it is to devote myself to learning when being sick.

Furthermore, I never stay behind when I can provide assistance or support to the people who are in need of help. I have done some volunteer work at Alpha Gamma Sigma and Phi Theta Kappa clubs at the college to help the socially and physically disadvantaged people. When the Bam earthquake happened in Iran, I could not stay indifferent and came there to provide my help as well. I volunteered to work as a translator to refugees and their sufferings produced a strong impression on me.

I have chosen Computer Science as my major since I believe that it is the field of study which can shape the future and make the universe a better place to live. I have never had a slightest doubt about choosing Computer Science as my intended major; it is my calling that fits my skills, ambitions and abilities. When being in my native country, Iran, I tried my best not to miss any opportunities to gain experience, extend my knowledge, or practice in Computer Study despite numerous financial and personal constraints.

My enthusiasm for computer study is accompanied with my passion for writing science fiction. I am proud of the fact that I have already completed the first novel. This is a kind of accomplishments which inspires hopes and makes me believe that my dreams will definitely come true.
